Rules of IYM Dachau

We don't accept

- racism, sexism, homophobia, transphobia, antisemitism, ableism or any further oppressive behavior and language
- participants smoking cannabis on the grounds of the Max Mannheimer House or its surroundings
- adult participants giving hard alcohol, tobacco, or cannabis to a minor participant
- adult participants smoking cannabis in the presence of a minor participant
- any possession of illegal drugs

Please be aware that this behavior leads to immediate exclusion of IYM Dachau.

It's forbidden

- to possess or consume hard alcohol* or cannabis
- to drink alcohol except in the bistro or the basement
- to bring alcohol to other rooms than bistro and basement
- to smoke cigarettes at other places than the bench in front of the hostel
- not to show up for obligatory parts of the program, without consulting project management
- to switch rooms / workshops / color groups without permission of project management
- to leave the house after 12 p.m. without knowledge of the night duty teamers

For minors it's forbidden

- to possess or consume hard alcohol*
- to possess or consume any kind of tobacco or cannabis
- to leave the house after 12 p.m. without supervision of a teamer/ project management
- to leave grounds of the Max Mannheimer House without signing the attendance list

We ask you

- not to wear national symbols or flags, especially if they are part of an ongoing conflict
- not to waste food: it's all-you-can-eat. Take smaller portions and if you're still hungry, you can always take another portion and another...
- to help the kitchen staff by cleaning up any mess you have made while eating
- to stay in the bistro or basement for partying and conversations after 10 p.m. If you're outside after 10 p.m. Keep the noise down.
- to keep the noise down in the basement after 12 p.m.
- to tell project management if you broke something
- to keep your room clean

* This also includes mixed drinks containing hard alcohol like Whiskey, Wodka, Rum etc.
